

# **Release Notes for Cisco FindIT Version 1.1.0**

#### January 2014

These Release Notes describe the requirements and known issues in Cisco FindIT version 1.1.0.

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## **Changes Since Version 1.0.1**

### **Major Changes**

• Added support for Internet Explorer 10, and Firefox 24, and above.

**NOTE** Internet Explorer version 7 and earlier and Firefox version 23 and earlier are no longer supported.

 Added support for Firefox running on an Apple Macintosh with OS X version 10.6 or above.

### **Release Notes**

- FindIT will automatically discover and notify the user when more recent firmware versions are available for any discovered devices. Firmware updates may be downloaded to the PC directly from the FindIT sidebar.
- FindIT will automatically discover and notify the user when updates to the FindIT application are available.

### **Other Changes**

- Added support for French and Simplified Chinese languages.
- Devices that are no longer visible on the network remain in the sidebar and change color to show that they are missing. The time since the device was last seen is shown in the information tooltip.
- Device categories will only be displayed in the sidebar if there are devices of that type discovered.
- FindIT will periodically send anonymized usage data to Cisco for the purposes of product improvement. This data may be viewed before transmission or data collection disabled through the settings menu.

### **Limitations and Restrictions**

Be aware of the following issues when using Cisco FindIT to monitor and manage the network:

**Problem:** The information tooltip for a device may not update correctly if a change is made to the device, such as changing the hostname or changing the number of devices in a stack. (CSCuj87869 & CSCul42374)

**Solution:** Select **FindIT** > **Refresh** from the FindIT toolbar.

**Problem:** If the administration GUI for a device is configured for HTTPS and a non-standard port, FindIT will not successfully open the GUI. (CSCul42356)

Solution: Configure the port to 443 or 8443.

**Problem:** FindIT is not compatible with Internet Explorer Protected Mode or Enhanced Protected Mode and will not operate correctly if they are enabled.

**Solution:** Either disable Protected Mode and Enhanced Protected Mode, or launch Internet Explorer using the **Run as administrator** method.

**Problem:** An attempt to upgrade from FindIT 1.0.x to FindIT 1.1.0 does not correctly remove all components of FindIT 1.0.x.

**Solution:** FindIT 1.0.x should be removed from the PC prior to running the FindIT 1.1.0 installer. Any customization made to FindIT 1.0.x will be retained during this process.

### **Requirements**

Your PC must meet the following requirements to run Cisco FindIT.

- Operating system:
  - Microsoft Windows XP SP3, 7 or 8
  - Apple OS X 10.6, 10.8 or 10.9
- Web browser:
  - Microsoft Internet Explorer 8, 9, or 10
  - Mozilla Firefox 24 or 25

**NOTE** When running on Windows XP, Cisco FindIT only supports Internet Explorer.

Your network devices must meet the following requirements to be monitored and accessed through Cisco FindIT.

- Must be on the same subnet as the PC that is running Cisco FindIT.
- Must be a Cisco Small Business device with the Bonjour service supported and enabled (see the Administration Guide or Online Help for the device).
