## Introduction

This document describes the reason samples and devices are not present in the current ThreatGrid Appliance (TGA) Dashboard and how to configure the TGA to do so.

# **Prerequisites**

#### Requirements

Cisco recommends that you have knowledge of these topics:

- Cisco ThreatGrid Appliance
- Cisco Firepower Management Center
- Cisco Email and Web Security Appliances

## **Components Used**

This document is not restricted to specific software and hardware versions.

The information in this document was created from the devices in a specific lab environment. All of the devices used in this document started with a cleared (default) configuration. If your network is live, ensure that you understand the potential impact of any command.

# **Background Information**

By default, TGA places the initial users into the Initial Organization and places integration devices into a separate organization that starts with VRT. Devices can be moved to the initial organization so further submitted samples show under the dashboard.

**Note**: Previously submitted samples do not move dashboards and remain in the current location.

# Configuration

**Note**: In a TGA Cluster, select any node to complete the required procedure. The procedure only needs to be completed once for all nodes to reflect the updated dashboard.

- Step 1. Log in to the Clean Interface of the TGA using the Admin credentials.
- Step 2. Navigate to **Administration > Manage Organization.**
- Step 3. Multiple organizations are listed; Initial Organization and at least one organization with VRT in the name (If no VRT group exists, troubleshoot connectivity between the integration device and the TGA).
- Step 4. Navigate to **Administration** > **Manage Users**.
- Step 5. Review the users and note the Organization that the Device/User is part of.
- Step 6. Repeat the procedure for each Device/User that needs to be moved.
- Step 1. Select each device from the VRT group and Select **Change Org** on the top right-hand corner.
  - Step 2. Type the name of the Organization noted in Step 5.
  - Step 3. Click Change.
- Step 4. Navigate to **Administration** > **Manage Users** and confirm the device is moved. All future submitted samples show on the dashboard for the Device/User.
